



New open-access battery lab!

The University of Washington's Clean Energy Institute (CEI) is expanding its open-access climate tech facility, the Washington Clean Energy Testbeds. Construction is underway for [a new lab](#) with state-of-the-art capabilities for scaled prototyping of emerging battery technologies. Come summer 2025, UW researchers and industry users will be able to produce batches of pouch cells—a versatile battery format for electric transportation and beyond—to allow for device engineering and testing at commercially-relevant scales. CEI shared lab details at an event with Washington Governor Jay Inslee, climate tech leaders, and clean energy researchers on October 11.
